### <u>Dress Code for Our Trip to</u> <u>Islam- Baitul Mukarram Masjid</u>

<u>A dress code is necessary for visitors to the Masjid. Appropriate dress is as</u> follows:

For boys: shirts with sleeves and pants or shorts that reach the knee at least.

<u>For girls</u>: shirts with sleeves and the length of the shirt needs to be long enough to cover the belly button and pants or skirts should be to the knee at least. Capris are acceptable.

### **Swimming Dress Code**
